



Frequently Asked Questions

What is mentoring?

- Mentoring is role modeling. It is using those "been there done that" experiences in our lives to help other women through similar circumstances. It is sharing how the Lord helped you through it and offering encouragement and assurance that He is there for the other person, too. Mentoring is coming alongside another woman and teaching her to seek God's Word and the One who has all the answers. --Janet Thompson, *Woman to Woman Mentoring*
- Mentoring ministry is for women of all ages based on Titus 2:3-5. It is a ministry that intentionally develops friendships among women of different generations. Women invest in the lives of each other through encouragement, guidance, listening, laughing, and loving. What is a Titus 2 woman?

Titus 2: ³Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good, ⁴and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, ⁵to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled.... ⁷Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works, and in your teaching show integrity, dignity, ⁸and sound speech that cannot be condemned, so that an opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us.

Who are mentors?

Mentors are women who are members/committed attendees of Redeemer's Fellowship who have a mature walk with Jesus. They may vary in age and interest. For many this will be a step of faith into something new, but you will receive TRAINING BEFORE YOU BEGIN!

Who can be mentored?

Any woman attending Redeemer's, regardless of age, who wants to grow in her faith, invest in a friendship, and be blessed!

How do I get involved?

Begin by filling out and submitting a Mentoring Profile. It is available online on the church website (www.redemeers.org) under Women's Ministry. Women will be matched, Mentor to Mentee, according to the profile they submit. The matching will be done prayerfully by Mentoring Committee members after September 2nd, the application deadline.

How much of a time commitment will this be?

This will be a 6 month commitment beginning September 28, 2018. On this date you will meet your mentor/mentee. On April 12, 2019 we will have a wrap-up celebration. Ideally, M&Ms meet weekly, however, the frequency, time, and place you meet will be determined as best fits the needs of you and your mentor/mentee.
